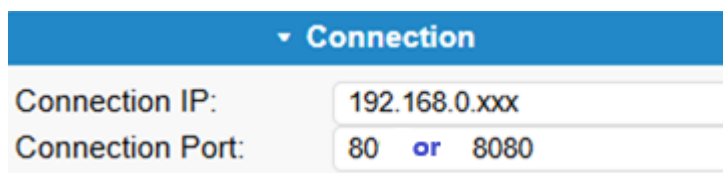


Instructions on how to launch the TIM API JavaScript Simulator

- Download the file “TIM API JavaScript Simulator.zip”
- Extract the zip file
- Navigate to .\TIM API JavaScript Simulator\ExampleECRAAdvanced
- Make sure you are located in the same network as the Terminal!
- Launch the file “start_server_for_JS.bat” on a Microsoft Windows System or use the file “start_server_for_JS.sh” on a Linux System

Example of how to test a “Purchase” Transaction with this JS Simulator

- Enter the **IP Address** of the Terminal with **Port** 80 or 8080 (depending on the Terminal Type) in the **Connection** section



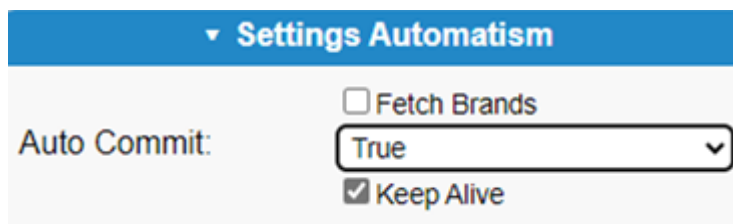

Connection Port: 80 or 8080

If you cannot enter an IP Address, as fields are greyed out, refresh your browser with CTRL – F5

- Set **Auto Commit** to **TRUE** in the **Settings Automatism** section



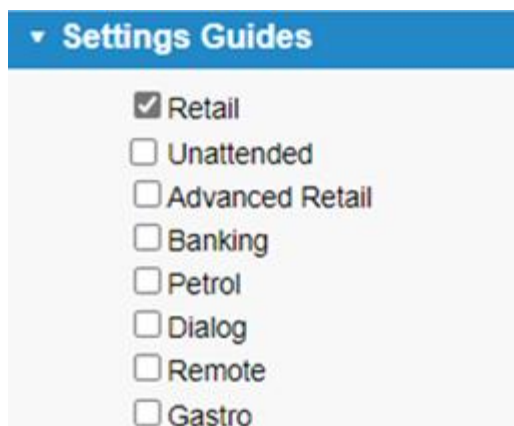

- Press on **Transaction**

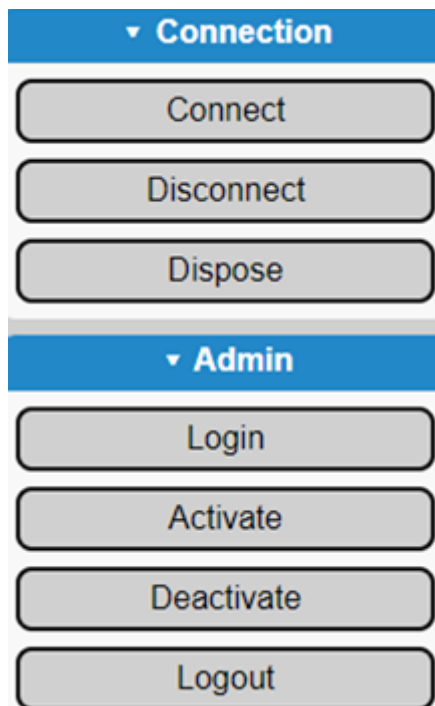
